Objectives:

- Understand why I need the Holy Spirit in my life

Your memory in action: "But anyone who doesn't love me, won't obey me. What they have heard me say doesn't really come from me, but from the Father who sent me." John 14:24

Exploring the Bible:

(To decorate the place where you teach, you must decorate with a lot of balloons).

Last week we started talking about the promise that Jesus made to us before going up to Heaven, that he would send a comforter. That comforter is called Holy Spirit. Who remembers what happened on his arrival? (Wait for the children's response) Something important that the people who were there were doing, what was it? (Wait for the answers) Exactly! They were praying.

Today we will be talking about what happened after the Holy Spirit descended and for that I brought a balloon (you need to take a balloon without blowing for you to illustrate the teaching) we can have a lot of fun with a balloon; How you used balloons? (Wait for answers) At parties are used to decorate, to play, colors and sizes are very fun.

The balloon that I have in my hands (the one you took to illustrate) is my favorite color Can someone tell me what is needed? (Wait response) Correct! It needs to be full of air, before the balloon fulfills its function for what it was created, which is all we mention, to decorate or play, first someone must fill it with air.

Just as the balloon must be filled with air to fulfill its function, the church needed to be filled with the Holy Spirit to fulfill all that God wished it to be. Before the Holy Spirit descended the whole church was hidden, gathered and silent, did not testify did not speak of Jesus. Jesus was no longer with them, they felt alone and afraid, but when the Holy Spirit arrived in their lives they began to tell everyone who saw Jesus, no matter the language, even in other languages they understood what they were talking to them, thousands of people were added to the church. The church came to life and they began to do what Jesus asked them to go and tell others.

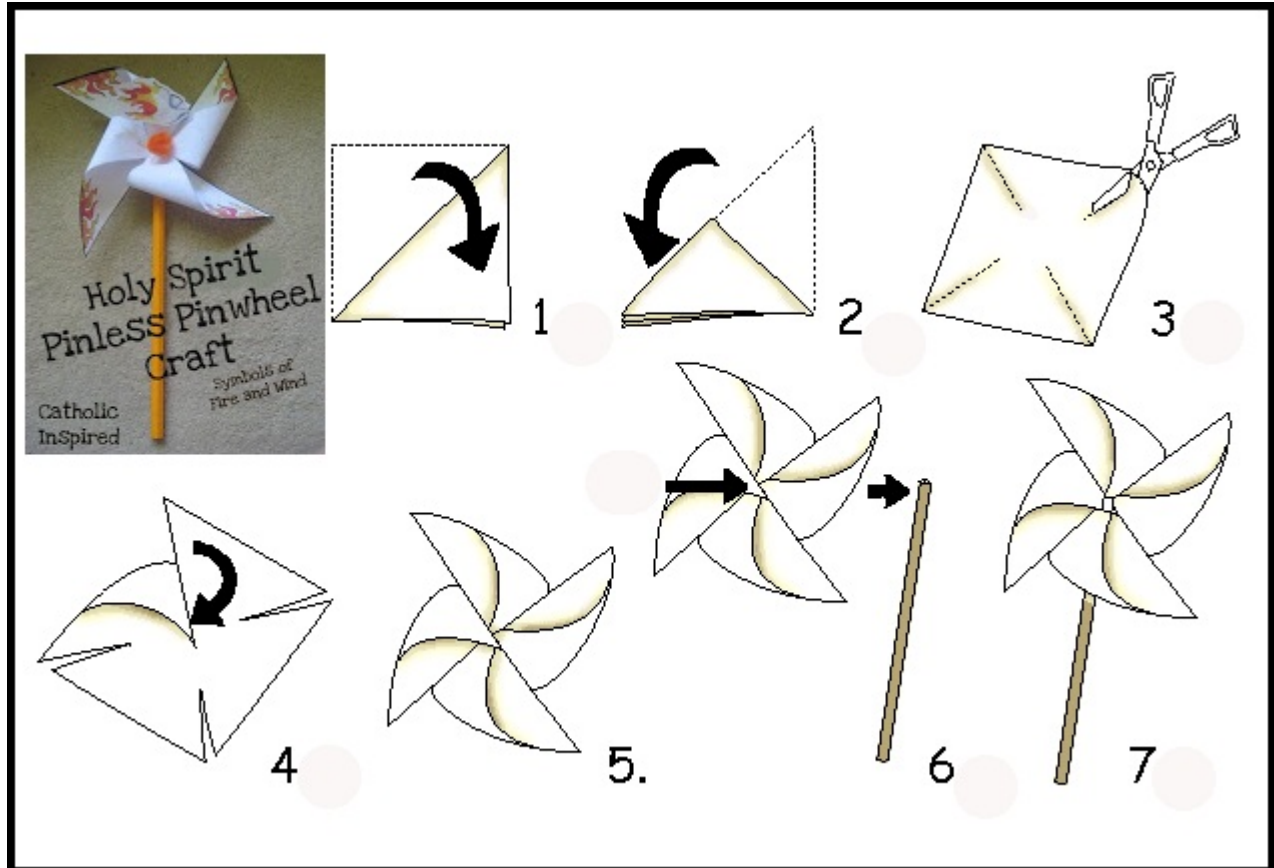
(Give a balloon to each child)

This balloon represents our lives, just as the balloon must be full of air to function, we must be filled with the Holy Spirit to be able to speak to others about Jesus, for that we were made. But first we need the Holy Spirit in our lives and for that we must ask for it, as the people were also doing the day of Pentecost.

Class Activity  
Kids from 3 to 12 years old

As we learned that the Holy Spirit is like the wind, we will make a paper windmill that through the wind will be able to move and we will see a great example that we need the Holy Spirit in our lives. With this craft they will remember and can use it in their school.

Materials: construction paper, a pencil with eraser for each child, tack with not so long tip, scissors and glue.



Instructions: Your teacher will give you a sheet of paper construction (the color you want) we know that the construction sheets have a measure of rectangle  and with the help of your teacher your paper should be like a cube (4 equal sides) when you already have your page with equal sides with the help of your teacher you will follow the image.

After you have your fan so it can work take your pencil with eraser (Very important that you have eraser) the center of the fan and the pencil you will join with your tack, there must be a space between the fan and the pencil so that you can move when you blow it.
