



The sacrifice of Jesus to put away sin

Hebrews 9: 24-28 *For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:25 Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:28 So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.*

There was a purpose in the sacrifice of Christ on the Cross of Calvary; Christ entered the same heaven to appear for us before God; He offered himself to remove the sin of many; He presented himself for the sacrifice of himself to carry sin; He will come again and save those who are waiting for him.

Christ presented himself to us before God. Hebrews 9: 24 *For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:*

The High Priest was to enter once a year to the sanctuary made of hands, which was the figure of the true sanctuary, and had to enter with blood to offer for himself and for the sins of ignorance of the people. But Christ did not enter into that sanctuary, but in heaven itself to appear for each one of us before God. Jesus ' sacrifice was to open the way to God. Jesus entered, not by blood of goats males or calf, but by his own blood, entered once and for all. The He appeared before the Father to intercede for you. If you have a need, a problem, or you are sick, remember that he presented himself before God, and intercedes for you.

Christ presented himself once and for all to put away sin. Hebrews 9: 25-26 *Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.*

The High Priest had to enter the holy place with blood of others once a year; But Christ did not have to offer himself many times, he presented himself once and for all for the sacrifice of himself. By its own sacrifice he arose once forever, in order to put away sin. That's why what The sacrifice of Christ takes away the sin. If you have failed, if you have committed sin, do not stay with that sin, if you confess, repent, and come to Jesus, he will take away your sin and give you salvation and eternal life.

Christ was offered only once. Hebrews 9: 28 *So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.*

Jesus was offered only once to carry the sins of many. When He died on that cross, Jesus came to offer himself, to give himself up to carry sins, to save us from condemnation and give eternal life. He came to die for you and for me. He died and rose again; He also ascended to the heavens and sat at the right hand of the Father, but he will appear again, he shall come a second time, unrelated to sin, he will come to save those who are waiting for him.

The Sacrifice of Christ in the cross it makes free from the captivity of sin, to anyone who believes in him and receives him as his Savior.



His broken body and his blood shed

Reading 1 Corinthians 11: 23-26 *For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, that the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread: 24 And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me. 25 After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. 26 For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.*

To learn 1 Corinthians 11: 27 *Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.*

It took the sacrifice of Christ to have forgiveness, salvation and eternal life.

They All have sinned, and they need the Lord's forgiveness. The relationship with God was lost, it was destroyed because of sin; Every man is under curse and is removed from the glory of God as long as he has not repented and confessed his sin. Forgiveness is the means by which the relationship with God is restored.

Forgiveness is erasing, not taking into account sin, forgetting sin, nullifying sin. It Is What God does in all those who come to him with a repentant heart, and willing to receive that forgiveness. God's forgiveness is to save sinners from eternal punishment, to accept them, to free them from the captivity of sin, to renew them and give them eternal life.

It was necessary the sacrifice of Jesus, it was necessary that his body was ground, and broken, and that his blood was shed on the cross of Calvary.

Without the sacrifice of Jesus, the forgiveness of sins was not possible, nor salvation of the soul.

The blood of a lamb without blemish was needed. Christ is that unblemished Lamb, so he went to the cross, being holy, just and good; He died for the sinners, and his life gave for the transgressors.

There Is an ordinance of Jesus about his broken body and his blood shed Lucas 22: 19 *And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me*

This Ordinance is the celebration of the Holy supper or the Lord's supper. This Ordinance is for us to do in memory of Jesus; In memory of the death of Jesus on the cross, and his blood that was poured out by all of us for the forgiveness of sins; This ordinance is also to remember that one day Christ comes for his people, who is waiting for him.

His body was given by us. Matthew 26: 26 *And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.*

He commanded to hold dinner, and said take, eat; You had to eat from his body. Dinner is to remember that expiating death on the Cross of Calvary; It is to remember the broken body of Jesus. It Is God's desire that we always make this reminder act, it is God's desire that this be in our memory. It was for us that he gave himself up, it was for us that he given his life. It Is important that you participate in the Lord's supper every time you are summoned; And it should not be taken lightly this ordinance which was given to us by Jesus himself, but should be partaken of it with reverent fear, remembering that he paid for us, and forgave our sins, and also carried our sicknesses, and by the sore on his body we were cured. **Isaiah 53: 4-5**

The new testament in my blood. Matthew 26: 27 *And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;*

The Lord wants us all to drink from his blood. We cannot ignore this mandate, we must partake of the Lord's Supper, this reminds us of the high price he paid so that we could have salvation and eternal life. It reminds us that the blood of Jesus Christ has power; he cleaned us up and brought us closer to God.

His blood spilled for us. **Lucas 22: 20** *"Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you. "* It Is necessary to live for God and according to His word in gratitude for what he did for us.

His blood was poured out for remission of sins. Matthew 26: 28 *For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.*

The Blood of Jesus was poured out for the forgiveness of our sins. Anyone who comes to repenting Jesus will enjoy all the benefits of the expiating death on the cross.

In the Sacrifice of Jesus, there was bloodshed, there was a body ground for our sins; There at the Calvary where the sacrifice was made, the Lamb of Glory was slain, suffered our sorrows, and brought our sickness.

Let's take Part in the body and blood of Jesus, remember that sacrifice so great that he did for us, and remember that one day we drink of this fruit of the vine with Jesus in the kingdom of God.

Matthew 26: 29 *But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.*
